

**Checklist for Minimum Standards for
School Sanitation and Hygiene Facilities**

- Separate latrines for boys and girls
- “Child friendly” facilities
- Latrines for male and female teachers
- 1 latrine per 25 girls and 1 for female staff
- 1 latrine + 1 urinal per 50 boys and 1 for male staff
- Handwashing stations next to latrines

Latrines should have

- Walls and roof
- Ventilation
- Doors that lock from the inside, not the outside
- Washable slabs
- Anal wiping material (paper, leaves)
- Waste basket for used wiping material
- A place to wash hands after use
- Cleaning items such as broom, scrub brush etc

Handwashing stations should have (at least)

- Basin
- Source of running water for rinsing (tap, jug)
- Soap, ash, clean sand or mud
- Soak pit to avoid standing water
