Latrines should have ☐ Walls and roof ☐ Ventilation ☐ Doors that lock from the inside, not the outside ☐ Washable slabs ☐ Anal wiping material (paper, leaves) ☐ Waste basket for used wiping material ☐ A place to wash hands after use ☐ Cleaning items such as broom, scrub brush etc
Handwashing stations should have (at least) ☐ Basin ☐ Source of running water for rinsing (tap, jug) ☐ Soap, ash, clean sand or mud ☐ Soak pit to avoid standing water
